## Who Are We Looking For?

- Ophea is looking for individuals who are passionate about Ophea's work and want to help improve the lives of Ontario students so they can value and enjoy the benefits of healthy, active living.
- Ophea Ambassadors are required to have strong interpersonal skills and excellent communications skills, with experience facilitating workshops in an organized and confident manner. Ambassadors also need to have the ability to adapt the workshop delivery to meet various needs and learning styles while drawing on the collective experience and expertise of the learners. An understanding of Ophea's goals and approach and the Ontario Health and Physical Education curricula is essential.

## What Does It Mean to be an Ophea Ambassador?

- As an Ambassador, your commitment will include:
- Being available between August 2023 to July 2024;
  - o attending a summer/fall training session;
  - delivering standard Ophea Professional Learning Workshops across the province, predominantly to educators but also to those interested in health and physical education from the health and recreation sectors. The number of workshops will be dependent on the number and topics of workshops requested and the number of Ambassadors available;
  - supporting (where appropriate) Ophea's work through communications activities, participating in social media, supporting online learning development; and
  - responding to various requests (e.g., reviewing resources, assisting with content writing/develop, participating in focus groups).
  - Ambassadors will be compensated at a set rate per workshop and reimbursed for approved Ambassador-related expenses, as per Ophea's Expense Guidelines.
- Supply teacher coverage costs are also covered by Ophea (if necessary).
