## Information Sheet - How Much Does It Cost To Smoke?





Most packs of cigarettes contain 20 cigarettes.

Canadian daily smokers aged 15 years and older consumed an average of 15 cigarettes per day in 2012.

In Ontario, the average cost of a pack of cigarettes is \$8.50.
