

Student Resource: Group Travel and Trail Etiquette - Self-Check (primary)

1. Place a checkmark on the line to show ways that you should travel as a group.

- stay behind the person who is leader
- keep up with the group
- know where your buddy is
- stay ahead of the designated sweeper
- race along the trail to find out how fast you can finish it

2. Place a checkmark on the line to show ways you can be a considerate hiker.

- only talk loud enough for the person near you to hear
- don't go off the trail
- let a person pass who is coming up the hill, moving to the right to allow them to pass you
- pass on the right side of people on the trail

3. What should you do if you get lost from your group? Select all correct answers.

- stay in one place
- blow your whistle or shout 3 times
- don't panic
