

# Student Resource: Fire Safety and Fire Building - Self-Check (primary)

1. Place a checkmark to show the rules you should follow to be safe around a fire.

- stay at least 3 big steps away from the fire
- don't put anything but dry wood on the fire
- keep anything like your clothes away from the fire
- make sure the fire is put out with lots of water
- don't have a fire if it's windy out

2. Place a checkmark to show 3 things you should do before you start the fire.

- go for a swim
- help collect the dry, dead wood for your fire from the ground only
- help clear the area near the fire of any twigs or other things that could catch on fire
- have a water supply ready near the fire before you light it to douse it quickly if needed

What 3 safety words should you remember so you know what to do if a campfire spark gets on your clothing?
