1. Select the checkboxes to show that you know some of the places that tick can be found.

- in the woods
- bushes
- under leaves
- in water
- in cut grass

2. Select the checkboxes to show that you know some of the things you can do to keep yourself safe from getting bitten by a tick.

- stay on paths and trails, the middle is best
- use insect repellent
- wear shoes that don't show your toes
- wear skin lotion so they won't stick on you
- wear long pants when hiking on a trail

3. What should you do immediately if you find a tick on you?

Question 2: Check all but “wear skin lotion so they won’t stick on you”.

Question 3: Don’t try to pull it off. Tell an adult who can remove it.
